**Subject:** PHU Access to COVID-19 School Absence Reporting Tool

The purpose of this memo is to provide an update on Public Health Unit access to the COVID-19 School Absence Online Reporting Tool.

The Ministry of Education is now granting PHU's access to the data collected in the COVID-19 School Absence Reporting tool. This information will provide timely information on the impacts of COVID-19 at the school and school board level, which may be of value for PHUs as a community surveillance measure.

It is critical that boards continue to use the absence reporting tool in order to ensure the most up to date and accurate information is available. Schools boards should continue to be in contact with PHU's for any suspected cases of COVID-19 in the school community.

In addition, we are happy to share that the Board COVID-19 Dashboard is also now available to access.
