Dear Colleagues,

Over the last decade, our government has worked closely with its partners to improve the delivery of student transportation. Together, we have made great strides in modernizing Ontario's student transportation system. This is an achievement we can all be proud of.

That is why, this fall, we will begin a broad engagement to renew the vision for student transportation in Ontario. Joan has served as special advisor to several Ontario school boards on behalf of the Ministry of Education, and is a past president of the Canadian Education Association and a member of the Order of Ontario.

Michel Paulin has vast management experience in the fields of education and finance. Previously, he served as superintendent of business at Conseil scolaire catholique Franco-Nord and as chair of the board of directors of the Ontario School Boards' Insurance Exchange. He has also served on various committees and task forces within the education and financial sectors, including the Ministry of Education's Declining Enrolment Working Group. Michel currently sits on the board of directors for Groupe Média TFO where he is chair of the audit committee. He is also a trustee of the Ontario Non-Union Education Trust.



The ministry will work with the executive co-leads to provide more information about the engagement process and its timeline in the coming months.
