This summer, the Durham District School Board will be offering a Summer Learning Program for current Senior Kindergarten to Grade 5 students. The program will focus on further developing students literacy and numeracy skills in a fun and engaging manner. Indigenous content and cultural learning experiences will be integrated throughout the course of the day. This program will be offered at Lakewoods Public School in Oshawa and will run for 3 weeks (15 days) from 9:00 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. from July 10 to 28, 2017.

It is the intent to offer small classes of 15 to 18 students per class.

There is no cost to enroll. Transportation is provided based on Durham District School Board guidelines. Parents are responsible for the safe arrival and return of students to and from school or bus pick up/drop off locations.

By registering for the program, parents are asked to commit to having their child attend **ALL 15 DAYS**.
